All Tied Up In Knots Supply List

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Don't get "tied up in knots" over making skinny bias strips for Celtic Knots, floral stems or Stained Glass quilting. Elsie's technique for making 1/8" wide bias is "sew" simple, you'll be amazed! You'll get a free pattern for an original appliqué block, along with expert instruction for needle-turn appliqué. Although this is a hand work class, instruction will include discussion and demonstration of machine applique techniques for bias as well. Hand work experience is a plus. Intermediate skill level. No sewing machine required. Half-day class.

MATERIALS:

- ✓ Fabric marking pen or pencil
- ✓ Fat Quarter light solid or print, for the background
- ✓ Fat Quarter dark solid or print, for the bias appliqué
- ✓ 50 or 60 wt thread to match the dark solid or print, cotton or silk
- ✓ Light or white thread, for basting
- ✓ Needle for appliqué (I suggest John James Gold'n Glide appliqué needles. Needles will be available for purchase in class, \$2.95 for 10.)
- ✓ Rotary cutter; ruler; cutting mat
- ✓ Sharp scissors for trimming fabric
- ✓ Iron and ironing surface (May be shared with a friend or provided by the show venue)

OPTIONAL but USEFUL:

- Sizing or spray starch
- Thread snips
- Sequin pins
- Needle threader
- Needle Grip-Its
- Needle Nanny
- Extra light (I like to use a bicyclist's head lamp. It is small, very portable, straps around your head, can be aimed at your work and best of all, does NOT need to be plugged in! You can find them at outdoor sports stores.)
