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Falling Leaves Supply List

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Traditional Nine-Patch blocks with curved piecing and Drunkard's Path blocks with simple appliqué combine to create this stunning bed-sized quilt. (*See photo.*) Learn machine piecing methods for curved seams, and easy machine and/or hand appliqué techniques, all in one full-day class. Pattern provided. Confident beginner to advanced levels. Sewing machine required. 5 to 6 hours. Instructor provide templates, freezer paper, fusible webbing, hand needles for class use.

MATERIALS for the complete quilt top (NOTE: You will not need all of this in class)

- 2 1/2 yards light print, for backgrounds
- 5 yards black solid for blocks, borders, and binding
- Assorted prints to total 3 1/2 yards

BEFORE CLASS:

No need to bring all of these pieces to class. Bring at least the suggested number in ().

- Cut 32: 6 1/2" squares light print (6)
- Cut 128: 2 1/2" squares light print (24)
- Cut 32: 3 1/2" squares light print (6)
- Cut 36: 6 1/2" squares black solid (6)
- Cut 160: 2 1/2" squares black solid (24)
- Cut 32: 3 1/2" squares black solid (6)
- Cut 9 each: 2 1/2" squares, assorted leaf prints to total 648 squares (54)
- Cut 68: 3 1/2" squares, assorted leaf prints (12)

EQUIPMENT & SUPPLIES:

- Ultra-fine line Sharpie™ marker
- Scissors
- *Rotary cutter, 6x12 ruler; and cutting mat (*Not needed during class, **IF** you've done all your pre-cutting, above!)
- Fabric marking pen and/or pencil (One white, one dark)
- Pins
- Neutral colored thread for piecing and appliqué
- Sewing machine, clean and in good working order, w/1/4" foot, & applique foot
- Iron and ironing surface
- Six-strand black embroidery floss, for veins in leaves and crewel embroidery needle
- Elmer's brand or other washable glue stick

(I will provide plastic templates for you, and squares of freezer paper along with your handout.)
