Fun with Flowers Supply List

MATERIALS:

- Strings and/or scraps of fabric to total at least 1 yard (Be sure to include lots of lights, mediums, and darks in flower colors, and include lots of greens and some yellow)
- 1 yard or more of a coordinating solid or print, for the background
- Neutral colored sewing thread
- 1 yard paper-backed fusible webbing (I prefer Steam-a-Seam Lite)

EQUIPMENT:

- Sewing machine, clean and in good working order
- One or two bobbins, filled with neutral colored sewing thread
- Rotary cutter, ruler(s), and cutting mat
- Mechanical pencil and ultra-fine line Sharpie marker
- Pins
- Seam ripper
- Scissors for paper and for fabric
- Flannel-backed tablecloth, for design wall
- Blue painter's tape, masking tape or tacks to hang 'design wall'
- Spray starch or sizing (Starch is actually my preference for this project, I mix liquid Sta-flo in a 1 to 1 ratio with water in a plant mister bottle. This is economical and more environmentally safe than the propellents found in aerosol sprays.)
- Iron and ironing board or ironing pad (can be shared with a friend)
